Sub:- Meeting / Work Shop for Public disclosure of MPRCP on 9th Nov 2016 in Bhopal.

Introduction

A meeting / workshop were conducted by Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority for public disclosure of Madhya Pradesh Rural Connectivity Project (MPRCP) on 9th Nov 2016 from 02:00 PM to 05:00 PM in Paryawas Bhawan, Arera hills, Bhopal. The consultants from World Bank and AIIB were also present. The PRIs from the district Raisen, Sehore, Bhopal, Vidisha and Hoshangabad were also invited vide MPRRDA letter No. 22759 dated 05.11.2016. Representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions including Zila Panchayat members, Sarpanchas, Gram Sachiv etc were present in the workshop. Amongst the Panchayati Raj Institutions some were representing scheduled caste and Scheduled Tribe classes and also some female members were present. Some General Managers, Assistant Managers, Sub Engineers and representatives of DPR consultants from Bhopal, Sehore, Vidisha, Raisen, Guna, Hoshangabad, Chhindwara, Jabalpur, Satna, Dhar and Ashoknagar etc districts were also present. As such there were about 46 participants in the workshop/ meeting.

Project's key Note

Firstly the brief description of Project was given to the community. The objective, size, scope and time period of project was disclosed to the attendees. It was informed that there is about 10,000 km of eligible existing gravel standard CMGSY roads which will be up graded to Bituminous Top (BT) standard. The eligibility/ Selection criteria was clarified. In general blocks, as per census year 2001, the population of target village between 499 to 150 and in tribal blocks population of target village between 249 to 100 will be covered under this project. Also alternative connectivity to villages through more social & economic useful village routes will be provided in all districts as per selection criteria, the total, length of such roads will be about 510 km in the State. The implementing agency (IA) of

this project is Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority, Paryawas Bhawan Bhopal under Department of Panchayat and Rural

Development, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh. It was also informed that as per concept paper the period of implementation of this project is about 5 years.

Cost & Funding of Project.

The total cost of project is about 500 million USD, 70% of this that is 350 MUSD will be loan component funded by world bank & AIIB jointly. 60% of loan component that is 210 MUSD will be provided by WB and 40% i.e. 140 MUSD will be funded by AIIB. Balance 30% i.e. about 150 MUSD will be counter funded by the State Government of Madhya Pradesh. There is also a component of Institutional Development/Capacity Development & road safety component in the Project.

Environment & Social Safe Guard (ESMF)

It was disclosed that Environment & Social frame work (ESMF) of this project was approved by the Bank; same is available on our website www.mprrda.com under "World Bank Section" and can be viewed by public at large.

The ESMF document comprises of four parts viz. (i) Environment Management Plan (EMP) (ii) Social Frame Work (SMF) (iii) Environment Code of Practice (ECOP) and (iv) Vulnerability Frame Work (VF).

The community was addressed by the World Bank & AIIB Social & Environment Experts and delivered much useful and relevant information on the subject. The Social & Environment likely impact of project was also discussed.

The MPRRDA's Safe Guard Cell has given relevant information on Social, Environment & road Safety related aspects of this project. It was informed by implementing agency i.e. MPRRDA that there will be no compensation for land intake (if required). If any part of private land is required at any place, same will be provided through volunteer donation by land owners. As this project is up gradation to BT of already constructed CMGSY gravel road, it is anticipated that there will be almost no additional land requirement.

Further, it was informed that if any electric pole/electric line required to be raised are shifted for safety, the same will be done appropriately under this project. If any public utility structure is affected due to this

project, provision for restoration of same will be done appropriately in this project.

The community was apprised of importance of awareness, sentisetization of roads safety, traffic rules, cleanliness, plantation & protection of trees and necessity for sustainable environment.

Consideration on Suggestion form Community

It was discussed with community that they are actual users/owner of rural roads & assets. They should keep the roads and shoulders free from encroachments and should not cut/damage the roads for their own use and should keep the road furniture, sign boards in safe usable conditions affety & convenience of roads users.

Some suggestions were also obtained from community for making the project more sustainable. Community has suggested in general, the necessity of irrigation crossing pipes, suitable ramps for towing bullock carts, and hand carts, tractors to road side from side by public paths. They also demanded for speed calming measures at main junction, near schools, habitation area. Provision for CC road and rigid shoulders in habitation area were also suggested. These suggestions and demands were discussed and it was appreciated by MPRRDA that the above kinds of suggestions would be included in DPR after technical verification by DPR consultants & PIUs engineers under the guidelines, standard parameters and scope of project. Villagers & PRI members assured that road side plantation, and also proper protection/care for up-keeping of plantation will be done through MNREGS or through other schemes as for as possible.

They also assured that they will protect the trees/plants in their area. Some PRI demanded bus stop sheds, in this regard it was informed that the provision of bus stop is not under scope of this project & it was suggested to take up the same with Gram Panchayat or other relevant agencies.

It was revealed that all public buildings like school, Panchayat Bhavan, Aanganwadi, Health Care centre etc which are within 50m from

project road & not having suitable approach, at such locations proper pucca approach will be provided under this project.

Grievance Redressal

It was also disclosed that if there is any grievances, complaints or suggestions from community during planning, execution same will be taken due consideration and resolved as far as possible, looking to the genuineness under the parameters/standards of project, under the grievance redressal mechanism enumerated in the ESMF document.

Community has assured for extending proper cooperation with the implementing agency and construction agencies during course of planning, design, construction and post construction maintenance period for betterment of Project. Community was very enthusiastic about this ambitious Project of Govt of M.P. The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks to all participants. The list of all participants from Community, WB, AIIB, MPRRDA, PIU's and DPR consultants present in this meeting is attached.
